DESCRIPTION

High-quality clearcoat with a high solids content. This lacquer has a reduced gloss level to about 50%, providing an elegant, silky matt finish.

The lacquer is specially developed for refinishing cars and is used for painting interiors, engine rooms and luggage compartments. It is resistant to various weather conditions, UV rays and stone chips. Even under heavy impact, the coating remains intact and prevents chipping.

MIXING RATIO



Mat clearcoat	100	
Hardener for Matt clearcoat	50	
Acrylic thinner	5-7%	Full flow
	0%	Orange peel texture

Comments: Stir thoroughly before use (2-3 minutes), in order to distribute the matting paste in the entire volume of paint. Amount of thinner calculated for weight of the clearcoat. Do not use other thinner than acrylic thinner.

APPLICATION



Number of layers	2

Mixture life after mixing clearcoat with standard type of hardener

60 min at 20°C

The first layer of clearcoat is applied to the pre-dried layer of basecoat. Second layer of clearcoat should be applied as a full layer and left to complete flow and hardening. Coating of clearcoat can be hardened by using IR heater. Please note that IR heater should not be turned on earlier than after about 15 minutes after application last layer of clearcoat. When painting large surfaces it is recommended to use a hardener and the acryl thinner - slow version.
